What is S.T.A.B.L.E.?

The S.T.A.B.L.E. program is one of the most widely distributed and implemented neonatal education program focused exclusively on post-resuscitation/pre-transport stabilization care of sick infants. It was developed to meet the needs of health care providers who deliver stabilization care to infants. The program’s acronym is a mnemonic referring to the six assessment and care modules, which are **S**ugar, **T**emperature, **A**irway, **B**lood Pressure, **L**ab work, and **E**motional Support.

Continuing Education
